

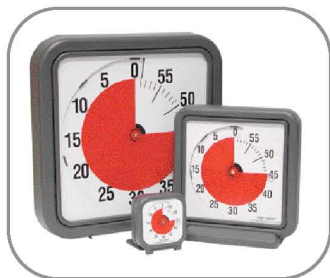

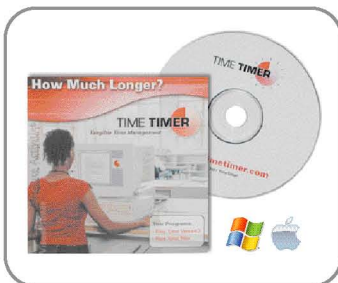

How it works:

To set the Personal, Original or Large Time Timer, move the red disk counterclockwise to the desired time interval. The disk diminishes as time elapses until no red is visible on the timer face. The disk may be moved clockwise or counterclockwise without harming the mechanism, however, gentle handling will prolong the life of the timer.



- Time elapses clockwise
- Timer is always on
- Quartz Movement
- Set at any point from 0 to 60 minutes
- Uses one AA battery
